

The 'top level' long term outcomes for Early Interventions 3 - 5 years are

- ❖ Reduction in the number of children assessed as needing formal social work intervention*
- ❖ Reduction in the number of young people offending*
- ❖ Reduction in the number of young people requiring to be educated outwith mainstream provisions*
- ❖ Reduction in the number of children going into independent, or out of authority, placements*

In year 1 it is proposed that key actions leading to the attainment of these top level outcomes should be as follows:
